

# Sharing SCRATCH Projects on a CD

While the Scratch website allows projects to be saved to the gallery section, some teachers may not want their students' projects on the Internet or may want the ability for students to take their projects home. It is possible to share student projects on both Windows and Macs by burning them to a CD.

To ensure projects burned to CD will play on ANY computer, certain files need to be included. These files can be found in the folder containing the Scratch application.
